Bovis Lend Lease will collaborate closely with the adjacent private land owner(s) to coordinate the tie-in location of backbone infrastructure facilities to meet all program objectives.

Approximately 84 percent of the project is publicly and privately owned parks, open spaces and recreation areas.

The mixed-use development will include business parks, retail services, transit related uses, a college campus, commercial recreation, residential units with senior housing, a private cemetery and golf courses.
